Answer to 5-29 Question: The Red Star Drug Store was a popular gathering place for the First  
Methodist Church youth and also some from neighboring churches. Located at the corner of  
Division and Main Streets, this drug store was about the only business open on Sunday. Behind  
the soda fountain at that time was a young lady who is a member of our church, Mayne Bess  
McGaugh Speed. According to Bess, the ice cream was handchurned in the back of the drug  
store by Mr. Homer Counts.

Question June 5, 2016: In 1957, it was a dream of Rev. James D. Jenkins to build an Education  
Building and provide the youth of the community a safe place to have fun. The Youth Center  
building and an adjoining parking lot were purchased and the church’s first Youth Director was  
appointed. During the 1960’s the Youth Center became the home of the poplar social center for  
the area youth. Do you know what it was and do you have a fond memory?
